

Are you Interested in Medication Assisted Treatment?

If so, apply for a Practitioner Waiver.

Apply for a practitioner waiver to prescribe or dispense buprenorphine under the Drug Addiction Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000).

To receive a waiver to practice opioid dependency treatment with approved buprenorphine medications, a practitioner must notify the [SAMHSA Center for Substance Abuse Treatment \(CSAT\)](#) of their intent to practice this form of medication-assisted treatment (MAT). The notification of intent must be submitted to CSAT before the initial dispensing or prescribing of opioid treatment.
